IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

IF YOU SIGNED UP TO WORK – PLEASE SHOW UP FOR YOUR SHIFT. If you can't work a shift you signed up for, please let **Mr. Toney** know in advance!

The morning delivery trucks **will leave at 8:00 am sharp!** Please be at the church at 7:45. The work clock starts at 8:00am. The afternoon delivery trucks will leave between 12:15 and 1:00, after lunch. If you miss the truck, it's your responsibility to find a ride to join the crew.

We will be trying new things to optimize our delivery truck runs. Please be patient, and put forth your best effort.

If you were asked to help load the delivery trucks on Friday Night, please be at the church by 6:00 pm.

Make sure you log your hours each day! It is your responsibility! Your mulch delivery crew leader (i.e., the truck driver or whoever they designate) will have the log sheet. Crew leaders are to turn in the log sheets to Mike Burns at the end of each day. If you forget, Mr. Wood's dog (Henry) will decide what you worked for that day. If Henry guesses incorrectly, don't complain to anyone, and look at it as a "learning experience." If you are "on the clock" you are expected to work; i.e., push a broom, stack pallets, clean up the lot, stack mulch, etc.

You will be assigned to a delivery or sales crew. The goal is to create balanced teams with both young and old scouts for delivery. The younger scouts will likely be assigned to a sales crew that will pre-sell near the trucks. If you have any physical limitations, please let Mr. Toney or Mr. Burns know (ASAP) so we can schedule you accordingly. Please don't complain about your assignment. Mr. Toney or Mr. Burns has the final call. Period.

If a scout is not dressed appropriately for the task assigned, they will be asked to go home and change. If the scout is coming from another event, please bring scout clothes to the church. Inappropriate scout attire reflects poorly on our troop, and can adversely affect future sales. This is not negotiable! Mr. Wood or Mr. Burns has the final call. Period.

The harder you work, the quicker we get done. The quicker we get done, the more money you earn per hour worked!
